



Group Airport Transportation Demand Rises Across British Columbia as Corporate Travel and Event Sectors Expand

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Bookings for private shuttle and limousine services to Vancouver International Airport have increased as organizations resume in-person meetings and conferences.

Demand for private group transportation to and from Vancouver International Airport has risen over the past year, driven by a recovery in corporate travel and an increase in large-scale events across the Lower Mainland. KJ Limousine Services Inc., a Richmond-based ground transportation company serving the Vancouver region and the Whistler corridor, has reported increased requests for multi-passenger airport transfers, executive event transportation, and corporate fleet bookings. The company has observed that group bookings now represent a growing share of its overall reservation volume compared with individual trip requests, and has adjusted its fleet and scheduling to accommodate the shift in demand.

The Vancouver Airport Authority reported that YVR handled more than 24 million passengers in 2024, approaching pre-pandemic volumes, with international traffic showing the strongest recovery. The authority's annual traffic summary noted that transpacific routes and connections to the United States accounted for the

largest share of growth, with December 2024 marking the busiest single month since early 2020. The increase in passenger volume has been accompanied by growth in ground transportation demand, particularly for services that accommodate groups traveling together for conferences, weddings, and corporate retreats, which require coordinated pickup and drop-off logistics.

In a statement, a representative from KJ Limousine Services said that the company has observed a shift in booking patterns toward larger group transfers, with organizations increasingly requesting multi-vehicle deployments for event arrivals and departures rather than scheduling individual trips. The company operates a fleet that includes sedans, SUVs, stretch limousines, and mini-coaches, serving airport transfers, corporate events, weddings, and custom group itineraries across the Lower Mainland. The company has expanded its fleet capacity over the past year to handle larger group bookings, adding additional vehicles to accommodate the increase in multi-passenger requests from corporate clients and event organizers.

British Columbia's tourism sector has reported steady growth in the meetings, conventions, and incentives market, with Vancouver hosting several major industry conferences in 2024 and 2025. The expansion of the Vancouver Convention Centre and new hotel developments in the city core have supported the growth of the corporate events sector, which in turn drives demand for group transportation providers. Destination Vancouver reported that convention-related bookings for 2025 are projected to exceed 2024 levels, based on confirmed event schedules and hotel occupancy data, pointing to another year of heightened demand for ground transport services that can handle simultaneous group arrivals and departures.

For ground transportation operators, the combination of rising air travel volumes and a strong events calendar has created sustained demand across both the corporate and leisure segments. The Whistler corridor continues to represent a significant portion of transportation bookings, with groups traveling between YVR and the resort destination during both the summer tourism season and the winter ski period. Operators serving the airport-to-Whistler route have noted that corporate incentive travel and executive retreats have been a particular source of growth in the past year, with multi-vehicle bookings becoming more common for large corporate groups traveling to the resort area for conferences and team events. The corridor's year-round tourism activity, with ski season running from November through April and summer travel peaking between June and September, provides consistent demand for group transportation services across both peak periods.
