Child support may help address a variety of everyday expenses connected to raising a child. These can include housing, food, clothing, healthcare, education, and other needs that arise as a child grows. The goal is to support a child's stability and well-being over time.

The firm also notes that circumstances change. Shifts in income, adjustments to parenting time, or changes in a child's needs may lead to future modifications when appropriate conditions are met. Understanding this possibility early can help parents plan for the years ahead.

"When parents understand the general framework early, they are better positioned to make informed decisions throughout their case."
